BJH Choir Newsletter October 28th, 2019

Hello everyone! It's the most wonderful time of the year again! That's right, it's time for Holiday Magic! I will do my best to cover everything you need to know for this concert and give you an idea of what is to come (Preview Night and competition season are right around the corner!). Holiday Magic (12/6 and 12/7) and Tech (12/5)

This year, the performances of Holiday Magic are on Friday and Saturday (12/6 and 12/7). **Friday's show starts at 7:00 PM and the two performances on Saturday begin at 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM.** The call time for each of the 7:00 PM performances is 6:15 PM for the students while the call time for the 2:00 PM show is 1:15 PM. Due to popular demand, the Brea Junior High choirs will be in all three performances for this concert. The location for each of these shows is the **Performing Arts Center at Brea Olinda High School**.

The **mandatory Tech Rehearsal** will be on Thursday for this performance. Costumes and make-up are not required for tech rehearsals. Students are only required to attend the tech rehearsal in the BOHS PAC until all of the numbers they will be performing in have finished rehearsing. However, students may stay and watch the rest of the rehearsal if they would like to. Here is the schedule for **Thursday (12/5):**

6:15-7:30 PM	Set all High School Acts (in order Thursday, Friday, & Saturday)

The concerts are expected to run between 2 and 2 ½ hours.

Please come dressed in your costumes with hair and make-up ready for the performance.

Costumes/ Hair and Make-Up

Dress is holiday snow clothes, warm pajamas, a Holiday character (Santa, Elf, a Present, Reindeer, etc.) or dressed up in bright Holiday colors! We do ask to keep away from more modern looking clothes (tennis shoes, jeans, etc.), flip flops, and clothes that make noise (pieces that jingle). We also ask, for safety, to avoid jewelry and make sure that the only earrings worn are studs. Other than that, the possibilities are endless!

As for hair and make up, our choreographer, Doug Kuhl, always asks for the girls to wear their hair half up and out of their faces. He also asks that they wear purple eye shadow and red lipstick, however, make-up may be different if it is costume specific for this concert. Boys do not need make up. We simply ask that their hair is presentable and out of their faces as well.

DVD Sales

As was the case with Fall Magic, our High School Booster Club will again be handling the production and sale of DVDs for Holiday Magic! Copies of each performance will be sold for \$30 and since we are making them ourselves, all proceeds will go back into funding our program. A Booster Club member will be taking orders at each of the performances and order forms will be available the following week. Cash, Venmo, and Checks made out to "Brea Olinda Choir Booster Club" will be accepted through Thursday, December 19th. All copies will be delivered within a few weeks of the shows.

Donations

Thank you to all of you who have generously donated to our program! We have had a decent amount of participation thus far in the year (especially with our fundraiser!). This helps us more than you know! Without it, we would not be able to accomplish anything close to what we do. Although we are now a few months into the school year, please continue to donate anything you can. We still don't have enough funds to cover our costume order and two scheduled competitions. Every little bit helps. Bills are starting to come in for competitions, music, set pieces, costumes, band members, etc. and we will need everyone to contribute to participate in everything that we hope to for the rest of the year.

Buying Tickets

To ensure that every family has a fair and equal chance to purchase the best seats, we will be continuing the ticket selling process used for Fall Magic. Tickets are \$12 and will typically go on sale the Monday of the week before the concert (The dates are also posted online on our class website calendar: http://mralexwillert.weebly.com/). For this concert, however, tickets will go on sale the Monday two weeks before the show week (11/18) due to Thanksgiving Break. On this Monday the tickets will only be sold at the BOHS PAC box office from 5-7:30 PM. All BOHS and BJH parents are welcome to have the first pick of tickets for the concert. However, anyone purchasing tickets on this night will need to sign up for a 15-minute purchasing window (ex: 5-5:15 PM) prior to the date. Each window will be limited to 15 purchasers. Anyone there who has not signed up for that slot will not be able to purchase tickets during that time. The link to this online sign up page is: https://signup.com/go/XsqsJHu

Please sign up anytime after the **page is unlocked Tuesday (11/12) at 9 AM.** After this process has concluded, tickets will only be sold in classes and at the box office before each show. Tickets sometimes sell out fast, so I cannot guarantee that there will be any left on the nights of the concerts. It is always best to purchase them within the first couple days that they are on sale. You can send in a **check (made out to "BJH Choir")** or cash with your child to buy seats. Please be sure to **specify which performance** you would like to attend.

Preview Night (1/10 and 1/11)

We are definitely coming up on our busiest season of the year. Although we are still preparing for Holiday Magic, we need to begin looking ahead to the next big concert: Preview Night. Believe it or not, it's on the week we get back from Winter Break! The tech rehearsal will be at 3:30 PM on Thursday (1/9) and the schedule will be posted on my website at a later date. There will be a 7 PM performance on Friday (1/10) and two shows on Saturday (1/11) at 2 PM and 7 PM. All show choirs from the High School will perform in each of the 3 performances, however for the sake of time, we will only be having our Junior High choirs perform on Friday Night and in the Saturday Matinee. Additionally, Thundercats will only be performing in the Saturday night performance.

Ticket sales will follow the same procedures we used for both Fall Magic and Holiday Magic. Those tickets will go on sale Monday, December 16th with the online sign up page being unlocked on Tuesday, December 10th.
