## Masquerade

(Choir families are asked to be responsible for $\$ 900$ per child for this choir)

This is our advanced competitive show choir with both boys and girls. They compete multiple times a year and are consistently ranked nationally as one of the top show choirs in America. This past year, we won multiple competitions and were ranked 32 nd in the country.

## Spellbound

(Choir families are asked to be responsible for $\$ 900$ per child for this choir)

This is our advanced competitive all female show choir. They compete multiple times a year and have reset expectations of what a top female choir can do over and over.

## Tiffany's

(Choir families are asked to be responsible for $\$ 600$ per child for this choir)
